Dear parent/carer

In an attempt to give you information as soon as possible so that you can make alternative arrangements for your children, I am letting you know the current plans which affect Seaburn Dene Primary School, as part of the national strike day on Wednesday next week. This information is current, however, there may still be changes right up to and including strike day itself.

The following year groups **will not attend school**, due to industrial action:

Reception  
Year 2  
Year 3  
Year 6

Unfortunately, in these circumstances, we have to be guided by health and safety and we do not have adequate cover to open these classes safely on the upcoming strike day. **There is an extremely limited number of places for children of critical workers, who have no alternative childcare on this day. These will be outside their normal year group and should only be considered, if you are a critical worker and have no alternative on Wednesday, form to complete: <https://forms.gle/CR5x2aKaEVLVHZtD7>**

If your child receives means tested Free School Meals and their year group is not attending school on Wednesday, we can offer a packed lunch for collection from school on the day. This will consist of a cheese bun (or dairy free alternative), shortbread biscuit, yoghurt, fruit and bottled water. School dinners will still be available for all of the children attending school. Any changes to these arrangements will be communicated via Class Dojo and the school website.
