Dear Parent/Carer

Further to the news of the industrial action proposed by the National Education Union (NEU), I am writing to you regarding the impact this will have on school after half term. The action is happening because of a dispute between unions and the government.

The proposed second date of this strike action is **Tuesday, 28th February 2023.**

From the information provided, I can currently confirm the following year groups will be CLOSED, due to this industrial action. Staff who are members of the NEU are not legally obliged to inform the Headteacher of their intention to strike.

Nursery, Reception, Years 2, 3 and 6.

If your children are in these year groups, the impact of the of the industrial action will mean that you will need to consider additional childcare arrangements on this day and the following planned strike days. If, however, you are a critical worker and have no other alternative childcare on this day, there is a very limited number of places, outside of your child/children's year group.
